B. Discussion and possible action to set meeting date of September 19, 2013 to adopt the tax rate for FY 2013-2014

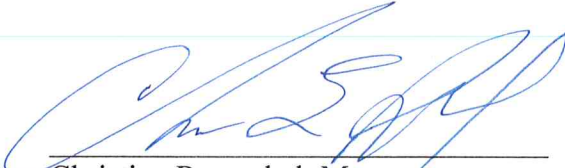
Motion was made by Councilmember Hampton to set the meeting date of September 19, 2013 to adopt the tax rate for FY 2013-2014.

Motion was seconded by Councilmember Morales. Motion carried 4-0.

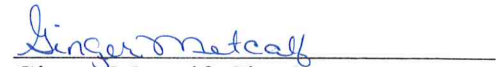
5. ADJOURNMENT
